WHEREAS, Ronald J. Neiss has served as a member of the Centerville City Beautiful Commission since his appointment on the 18th day of July, 1974, and








WHEREAS, Ronald J. Neiss, for personal reasons, finds it necessary to resign from his term of office, and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:



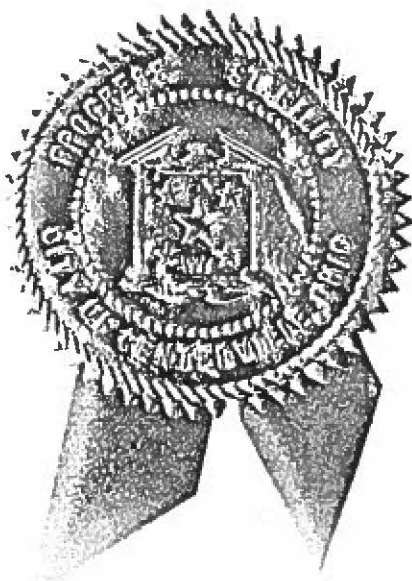
