

RESOLUTION NO. 23-77
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN McQueeney ON THE 20th
DAY OF June, 1977.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MAJOR ROAD IMPROVEMENT FUND AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO ESTABLISH SAID FUND IN PROVIDING FOR PAYMENTS INTO AND OUT OF SAID FUND.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. There is hereby established a Major Road Improvement Fund. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all steps necessary to establish said fund and, further, is authorized and directed to pay into said fund all money received from property taxes collected by Montgomery County in behalf of the City of Centerville from a 1.62 mill levy approved by the voters in the June 7, 1977 Special Election and to make payments out of said fund for the purposes provided by law.
