A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SALARY INCREASE FOR THE
CLERK OF COUNCIL.

two employees directly employed by, responsible to, and supervised by the
City Council; and,

WHEREAS, after having evaluated her performance, the City Council
finds that her overall performance is substantially and consistently above
average, and further finds that a salary increase is justified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF
CENTERVILLE THAT;

The City Council authorizes and directs the increase of
compensation for the Clerk of Council in accordance with
the salary schedule cited in Ordinance No. 100-75. 3A
from \$11,003.20 to \$11,544.00 per year. Said increase to
be effective on June 1, 1976.
