The undersigned, having full knowledge of the site, plans and specifications for the following improvement, hereby proposes to furnish all materials, labor and equipment, and to construct in every respect complete:

Curb installation around the center island of Rahn Road, from Marshall Road east to the railroad track, a distance of approximately 2800 feet; construction of turn lanes and repairing of a certain stretch of westbound Rahn Road.
