AMENDED SPECIFICATIONS FOR CENTERVILLE, OHIO, BID ON ELECTRONIC CALCIUM CHLORIDE APPLICATOR

CONSTRUCTION

Molded fiberglass weather protector housing the brine solution pumping system, the hydraulic motor, pump and flow control valves, and the electrical enclosure.

Brine pumping system. Electric. Stainless steel pump with 100 gallon/minute zero head capacity with 1 H.P. 115/230 V. single phase motor, TEFC. Necessary hose adaptors and plumbing fittings.

Hydraulic system. 1500 p.s.i. pump with adjustable valve. Flow control valves, electronic solenoid, 2 inch cylinder, necessary hose and swivel.

Molded fiberglass electrical products enclosure housing the receivers, relays, timers, motor overloads, circuitry board.

Molded fiberglass "wetting arm" with steel T-bar support, schedule 80 P.V.C. fittings, brass nozzles, the necessary hose and adaptors. Assembled for attachment.

Steel channel assembly. One piece unit with mounting holes for attachment to poles or building. Shipped with hydraulic cylinder and fiberglass protector attached.

Coating. All fiberglass molding. All exposed steel fittings primed with undercoat.

Storage tank. 5,600 gallon/capacity, flat bottom, dome top, molded, seamless high density cross linked polyolefin construction with inhibitors. Approximate 16 inch manway and 2 inch outlet provided. Nominal wall thickness approximately 5/8 inch.
