A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH MONTGOMERY COUNTY FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF THE COUNTY IN UNDERTAKING ESSENTIAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville is interested in a program of community development and renewal, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to obtain funds to achieve such goals and objectives as provided by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, and

WHEREAS, said Act encourages counties to enter into Cooperation Agreements with cities in their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, Montgomery County has expressed its desire to qualify as an Urban County under the provisions of the aforementioned Act;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

- Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Cooperation Agreement with Montgomery County, State of Ohio for the assistance of said County in undertaking essential community development activities.
- Section 2. Said Agreement shall be subject to the following provisions:
 - (A) Distribution of Urban County formula funds shall be based upon the degree to which each project has met the findings and purpose of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.
 - (B) The City shall have the option to implement those community development projects to be conducted within the City which are traceable to the use of Urban County formula funds.
 - (C) Distribution of Urban County formula funds shall be in accordance with the emphasis of urban area problems established by the Congress in the passage of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.
 - (D) Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Agreement, the City does not relinquish any of its rights, powers, responsibilities or privileges, and may refuse implementation of any eligible activity either within or in close proximity to the City of Centerville which activity was neither initiated nor approved by the City.
