
WHEREAS, The City of Centerville has long recognized the need for beautification in the community in order to make Centerville an attractive, pleasant area in which to live, work and shop; and




WHEREAS, The beauty of any city is in large measure dependent upon the interests and cooperation of its citizens and businessmen; and




