CLERK OF COUNCIL.


WHEREAS, the Clerk of Council, Marilyn McLaughlin, is one of the

WHEREAS, after having evaluated her performance, the City Council
finds that her overall performance is substantially and consistently above
average, and further finds that a salary increase is justified.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE
THAT;

The City Council authorizes and directs the increase of compensa-
tion for the Clerk of Council in accordance with the salary
schedule cited in Ordinance No. 32-75. SA from \$10,130 per year
to \$10,629 per year. Said increase to be effective on June 1,
1975.
