

RESOLUTION NO. 37-75

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN David Lake ON THE 7th DAY OF July, 1975.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CASE OF REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND/OR THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville hereby declares the existence of a case of real and present emergency arising in connection with the purchase of police vehicles for the City of Centerville; and

WHEREAS, Section 737.03 Ohio Revised Code provides that the Director of Public Safety shall be governed by Sections 735.05 to 735.09 inclusive of the Ohio Revised Code in connection with the purchase of police vehicles; and


WHEREAS, Sections 735.051 Ohio Revised Code provides that in the case of a real and present emergency Council may, by a two-thirds vote of all members elected, authorize the Director of Public Safety or the City Manager to enter into a contract for the purchase of said vehicles:

NOW, THEREFORE,


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety and/or the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid for police vehicles attached hereto marked Exhibit A and incorporated herein without advertisement for said bids because of the fact that no other said vehicles are available and said vehicles are immediately needed by the City of Centerville preserve, protect and promote the public safety of the citizens of Centerville.


