

RESOLUTION NO. 107/75

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

Rev. Code, Sec. 5705.19, .192, .26

The ² Council of the City of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, met in Regular session on the 2nd day of September, 1975, at the office of the Council Chambers with the following members present:

- Deputy Mayor J. V. Stone
- Councilman Russell Sweetman
- Councilwoman Nora Lake
- Councilman Ralph Spencer
- Councilman Leonard Stubbs

Mr. Spencer moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said City of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the City of Centerville

for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, and other equipment, used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent police personnel under Ohio Revised Code, Section 5705.19 (J)

at a rate not exceeding 2.00 (two) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$.20 (twenty cents)

for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of .76 mills and an increase of 1.24 mills to constitute a tax of 2.00 mills

(If the levy is a renewal of an existing levy, or an increase or decrease, insert as part of the resolution "and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of ... mills" or "and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of ... mills and an increase of ... mills to constitute a tax of ... mills" or "and which levy is a renewal of part of an existing levy, being a reduction of ... mills to constitute a tax of ... mills")

RESOLVED, That said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of this Council of the City of Centerville be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Montgomery County, Ohio, prior to the fifth day of September, 1975

and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

7. This notice to be given by the Board of Elections shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the subdivision once a week for four consecutive weeks prior to the election.
