
SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Robert Springer ON THE 15th DAY OF September, 1975.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICE LEVY FUND AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO ESTABLISH SAID FUND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENTS INTO AND OUT OF SAID FUND.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. There is hereby established a Police Levy Fund. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all steps necessary to establish said fund and, further, he is authorized and directed to pay into said fund all money received by the City of Centerville from the Police Levy and to make payments out of said fund for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, and other equipment, used directly in the operation of the Centerville Police Department or the payment of salaries of permanent police personnel under Ohio Revised Code, Section 5705.19(J).
