A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ALLOCATION OF INCOME TAX RECEIPTS BETWEEN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND AND THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


Section 1. From all municipal income tax receipts by the City, the following allocation is hereby to be made between the Capital Improvements Fund and the General Fund:

To the Capital Improvements Fund-Twenty Five (25%) percent,


To the General Fund-Seventy Five (75%) percent.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary action in order to carry out the allocations provided for herein.
