A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO JOIN WITH THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY PURCHASING DEPARTMENT IN ADVERTISING AND SOLICITING BIDS FOR GLASS BEADS AND TRAFFIC PAINT.

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Purchasing Department proposes to advertise and solicit bids for glass beads and traffic paint; and

WHEREAS, said Purchasing Department has invited this City to participate with it in said advertising and solicitation with the decision to accept or reject bids being reserved to this City; and



NOW THEREFORE:


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


