

RESOLUTION NO. 11-74

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Russell Sweetman ON THE 18th DAY OF MARCH, 1974.

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL 671.

WHEREAS, there is presently pending before the Ohio General Assembly, House Bill 671 which bill, if it should be enacted into law, would assure county governments of a percentage of the Local Government Fund instead of requiring counties to compete in the determination of relative need with municipalities and townships as is now required; and

WHEREAS, such legislation, if passed, would be detrimental to the continued responsiveness of those governmental bodies which are the most directly responsible for the needs of individual citizens i.e. municipalities and townships; and

WHEREAS, the needs of citizens can best be served by continuing to require that participation in distributions from the Local Government Fund be based upon merit rather than assured percentages which might have no relation to merit or the needs of the public;


NOW THEREFORE

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


Section 1. That the Council of the City of Centerville hereby opposes the passage of House Bill 671 for the reasons set forth above.
