AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RESOLUTION 28-73
BY EXPOUNDING THE SISTER CITY COMMITTEE
MEMBERSHIP FROM FIVE TO SEVEN.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. Section 1. of Resolution No. 28-73 is hereby amended as follows:

There is hereby created and established in and for the City of Centerville, a committee to be hereafter known as the "Sister-City Committee," which shall consist of [five] seven members to be appointed by the City Council; such members of the City to serve for three-year terms of the members of the first committee appointed, three shall expire in three years, two in two years and two in one year respectively as indicated by the action of the City Council in making the original appointments; it is further provided that a member of Council shall be an ex officio member without voting power.
