SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN J. V. Stone ON THE 29th DAY OF April, 1974.

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF JAMES R. SMITH AS CITY MANAGER EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 1974 AND RETAINING THE SAID JAMES R. SMITH AS A CITY MANAGEMENT CONSULTANT TO THE CITY FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS THEREAFTER.

WHEREAS, James R. Smith has submitted his resignation as City Manager of the City of Centerville effective June 1, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville is willing to accept said resignation only on the condition that James R. Smith is willing to continue as a City Management Consultant for the City for the necessary transition period to a new City Manager which is deemed to be six months; and

WHEREAS, James R. Smith is willing to serve as a City Management Consultant for said period.


NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


Section 1. The resignation of James R. Smith as City Manager of the City of Centerville effective June 1, 1974 is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Centerville is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a consultant's agreement with the said James R. Smith for a period of six months commencing June 1, 1974 in consideration of the payment to James R. Smith of the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Seven and 50/100 (\$1,437.50) Dollars per month for the six month period all as evidenced in the proposed contract attached hereto, marked Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.
