RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORRIDOR
LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT SYSTEM
LOCAL FUNDING SHARE OF CAPITAL COST

WHEREAS, the communities in the southeast corridor of Montgomery County have adopted the proposal to implement a light rail transit system; and

WHEREAS, the TCC staff was directed to take the necessary steps for insuring implementation of this system; and

WHEREAS, agreement on a local funding approach is required as a part of the capital grant application which will be filed with the Urban Mass Transportation Administration of the U. S. Department of Transportation; and


WHEREAS, the TCC staff was directed to cooperate with the appropriate governments in the establishment of an equitable financial participation plan; and

WHEREAS, a committee of representatives from the jurisdictions in the southeast corridor have concurred in a local funding procedure pending an audit of the calculations and final agreement on the various weights assigned to land use types and distance from the transit facility.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Centerville City Council hereby endorses the local funding formula as noted in paragraph 5 above for "Local Funding Allocation Formulas for Southeast Corridor Rail Transit System - Part III", dated May 9, 1974, for the distribution of the local capital costs.


