TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.


WHEREAS, the City advertised for bidders for applying

PROPOSAL

Proposal for applying bituminous material to various streets in the City of Centerville, Ohio.

I/we, the undersigned, having carefully examined the "Construction and Material Specifications" of the Department of Highways, State of Ohio, insofar as they pertain to bituminous road surfacing material which I/we understand is sufficient for the purpose, hereby propose to furnish all equipment, labor and materials to properly prepare certain street surfaces in the City of Centerville for resurfacing, applying a suitable tack-coat of liquid asphaltic compound (407) at the rate of .2 gallon per square yard and applying a wearing course of T-35 (404).

Prevailing wage scale for Montgomery County as issued by the State of Ohio, Department of Industrial Relations at the time of bidding must be paid.

The City is reserving the right to reject any or all bids or to accept parts of bids or to change the amount of any item. (Bid must be accompanied by 5% Bid Bond or Certified Check). Successful Contractor is to furnish 50% Performance Bond. The City is also reserving the right to designate the date for the start of certain parts of the project, and to postpone resurfacing of certain roads till concrete curb and/or berm adjacent to such roadways is installed. In no case shall the required starting date be later than September 1, 1974.

Work will start within 30 days from receipt of direction to commence work, and will be completed in 60 days.
