SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Charles McClellan, ON THE 15th DAY OF July, 1974.

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT WITH REGARD TO A PROPOSED DISASTER WARNING PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville believes it is in the best interests of its citizens and the citizens of Washington Township, Montgomery County, Ohio to establish a disaster warning program for said committee; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council of the City of Centerville to fund a disaster warning system and to apply for 50% matching funds from the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville's share of said funds are available;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The City of Centerville hereby expresses its intent to proceed with the institution of a proposed disaster warning program for the City of Centerville and Washington Township, Montgomery County, Ohio and, further the said City of Centerville hereby expresses its intent to apply for 50% matching funds from the Federal Government.


