
Whereas, the City advertised for bidders for gasoline for the City of Centerville, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City; and


We are pleased to submit our quotation for gasoline requirements for the next twelve months, beginning July 1, 1974, subject to the following conditions:

2. Terms will be Net 30 Days date of delivery.
3. We no longer furnish equipment for consumer customers, therefore, it will be necessary for the City to purchase any existing pumps, and/or tanks from another oil company or from your present supplier.
4. Deliveries of both gasoline and diesel fuel will be subject to the State and/or Federal Allocation Regulations that may come into effect. Deliveries will also be subject to our own allocation fraction, depending on our available supplies.

We have enjoyed the privilege of supplying your fuel needs in the past and are looking forward to continuing this relationship to our mutual advantage.
