
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF DAYTON FOR USE OF THE CITY OF DAYTON'S HUMAN REHABILITATION CENTER FOR QUARTERING PRISONERS OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the City of Dayton for the quartering of prisoners at the City of Dayton's Human Rehabilitation Center in consideration of the payment of Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$11.50) per male prisoner day and Six Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$6.75) per female prisoner day, said contract to be for the term of January 1, 1973 to January 1, 1974 and indemnify and save harmless the City of Dayton from any costs or expenses for medical or dental treatment of prisoners.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
