

RESOLUTION NO. 9-73

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Russell Sweetman ON THE 19th DAY OF February, 1973.

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE LOCATION AND TYPES OF VARIOUS SIDEWALKS TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN THE VICINITY OF THE NEW CENTERVILLE HIGH SCHOOL AND DESIGNATING THE COUNCIL'S INTENT CONCERNING CONSTRUCTION OF SAME.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

Section 1. A new sidewalk at least four (4) feet in width and of concrete construction shall be constructed across the full road frontage of the new Centerville High School where same abuts East Centerville Station Road and said sidewalk shall be built within the street right-of-way but to the south of the paved portion of the highway such distance as may be approved by the City Engineer and said construction shall be at the cost of the Centerville City School District; to the east of the aforesaid sidewalk of the Centerville City School District and extending from its easternmost terminus eastwardly to Clio Road there shall be constructed, within the street right-of-way, at the cost of the City of Centerville, a temporary blacktop sidewalk.

On the north side of East Centerville Station Road there is an existing sidewalk across said road from the aforesaid new high school site and the Council of the City of Centerville hereby expresses its intention that a new permanent concrete sidewalk four (4) feet in width should be constructed from the easternmost edge of the aforesaid existing sidewalk eastwardly to Clio Road at the expense of the owner of the land abutting said East Centerville Station Road within said distance to the north and said concrete sidewalk shall be constructed within the street right-of-way by the said owner of the underlying fee. To the east of said Clio Road and along an imaginary line extending eastwardly from the aforesaid sidewalk to the north side of East Centerville Station Road, there shall be constructed within the street right-of-way and at the cost of the City of Centerville, a temporary blacktop sidewalk which shall extend eastwardly from Clio Road to an existing sidewalk which presently runs westwardly from Rain Tree Drive.

Section 2. The City Manager and City Engineer are hereby authorized and directed to notify all property owners of the intention of the City of Centerville as expressed by its Council herein and, in those cases where a permanent concrete sidewalk is to be constructed by said owner, said City Manager and City Engineer are directed to request said owner to undertake such construction and to be advised that if such construction is not undertaken by the owner, it will be undertaken by the City of Centerville and assessed to the owner as provided by law. The City Manager and City Engineer are authorized to grant said owner a reasonable period of time within which to commence said construction.
