
Whereas, the City advertised for bidders for new 8-track logging-recording equipment for the City of Centerville, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City; and

Dictaphone Corporation is pleased to submit its Proposal in response to your request for Bid for "New 8-Track Logging-Recording Equipment".

The following attachments constitute our Proposal to you in this regard:

- a. Bidder's Price Proposal, in the amount of \$7,846.
- b. Certified Check as Bid Deposit, in the amount of \$450.

In reviewing the Bid Specifications, we have noticed that no mention was made of a High Speed Time Reader (Model 4520). This equipment is a necessary complement to the High Speed Time Generator, since it reads the time codes which have been placed on the tape by the associated High Speed Time Generator. The absence of this equipment virtually eliminates the Series 4000 search capability. Therefore, we strongly recommend the purchase of the High Speed Time Reader (Model 4520). Dictaphone Corporation agrees to furnish this equipment at the additional cost of \$1,116.


