A RESOLUTION OF OPPOSITION TO THE DRAFT DATED  
APRIL 18, 1973, FROM THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL  
PLANNING COMMISSION DETAILING AMENDMENTS  
TO THE CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE  
MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments to the constitution and by-laws  
of The Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission could result in a  
Regional Planning Commission not based on representative government and  
not responsive to the needs of its local members; and


WHEREAS, the City of Centerville must protect the identity of its  
citizens and such protection would be jeopardized if the proposed amendments  
to the constitution and by-laws of the Miami Valley Regional Planning  
Commission are adopted; and

WHEREAS, the original idea of the Miami Valley Regional Planning  
Commission was to assist local government in its own planning and if other  
amendments are passed it would result in the Miami Valley Regional  
Planning Commission being in a position to impose its planning on local  
governments in contravention to the original idea of the Regional Planning  
Commission.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY  
RESOLVES:

That the Council of the City of Centerville hereby expresses its  
opposition to the proposed amendments of the constitution and by-laws of  
the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission and requests that said  
amendments not be adopted.
