A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CENTERVILLE ARTS COMMISSION TO PROCEED WITH PLANS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CENTERVILLE MAGAZINE KNOWN AS " CENTERVILLE LIFE ".

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of June, 1973, the Centerville Arts Commission, at a meeting of said Commission, adopted a proposal for a magazine to be known as "Centerville Life" which proposal is more fully set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville is of the opinion that the proposal has great merit and deserves further explanation; and

WHEREAS, the Centerville Arts Commission has asked the Centerville Council for a Resolution endorsing the idea of said magazine;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipality of Centerville;

Section 1. That the Centerville Arts Commission is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with its plans for developing a Centerville magazine to be known as "Centerville Life" in accordance with the proposal contained in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, provided, however, that in view of the fact that said magazine will, in all probability, have great impact on the City of Centerville, its residents, and the surrounding area, the Council of the City of Centerville will not authorize distribution of said magazine until such time as the format and contents thereof have been submitted to and approved by said City Council.

Section 2. Any resolution, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded and repealed.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

## CENTERVILLE MAGAZINE

We propose a 32-page, 5"x7" magazine printed in one color on colored stock, published twice a year. The purpose of the magazine will be to promote Centerville in general and its artists, writers and photographers in particular. Since the magazine will be published by the Fine Arts Commission, the emphasis of the magazine will be literary, rather than commercial, as most Chamber of Commerce magazines are.

An initial print order for 5,000 copies is planned. The magazines will be sold in area stores and distributed free of charge by Welcome Wagon and similar organizations.

The magazine will be titled "Centerville Life."

Sample content: Photographic spread of Centerville by at local photographer, profile of Phil Donohue, article by Erma Bombeck (former resident), article featuring the Old Fashioned Days Festival, short history of Centerville, poems and stories by local writers, etc.
