WHEREAS, John A. Zengel has served the City of Centerville and its citizens as a member of the Centerville City Council; and


WHEREAS, in his capacity as a Centerville Councilman, John A. Zengel has given of his time and energy for the benefit of the City and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville deems it fitting and proper that it should express its appreciation and that of its citizens to John A. Zengel for his faithful service;


NOW, THEREFORE:
