A RESOLUTION RATIFYING A CONTRACT WITH BOWSER-MORNER TESTING LABS, INC. FOR THE CONDUCT OF TESTS FOR THE STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the action of the City Manager in executing a contract with Bowser-Morner Testing Labs, Inc. to provide for the conduct of tests for the street re-surfacing, the performance of daily required composition analysis and other services for a unit fee of \$.25 per ton and a minimum fee for two men at the rate of \$60.00 a day is hereby ratified and adopted by the Council as the duly authorized action of the City Manager on behalf of the City of Centerville, Ohio.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
