
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT FOR THE PERIOD OF ONE YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 1973.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Montgomery County Board of Health whereby said Board of Health would conduct a public health program and render public health services for the City of Centerville for one year commencing January 1, 1973, equivalent to the program carried on within the Montgomery County General Health District in consideration of the payment by the City of Centerville of the sum of Fifteen Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Three (\$15,383.00) Dollars plus the amount of reimbursement received from the State Treasurer and generally known as State Subsidy to Local Health.


Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.


