

RESOLUTION REQUESTING FISCAL OFFICER TO
CERTIFY AS TO MAXIMUM MATURITY OF BONDS

The Council of the City of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, met in Special session on the ^{24th}~~23rd~~ day of September, 1970, with the following members present:

Mr. Davis moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, this Council contemplates the issuance of bonds in the sum of \$40,000 for the purpose of acquiring garbage packer trucks and related equipment, and notes in anticipation of such bonds;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Centerville, Ohio, that the Director of Finance as fiscal officer be and he is hereby requested to certify to this Council the estimated life of the equipment to be acquired with the proceeds of the sale of said bonds and the maximum maturity of said bonds and notes, as provided in Sections 133.20 and 133.21 of the Uniform Bond Law of the Ohio Revised Code.

Mr. Green seconded the motion, and the roll being called upon the question of adoption of the resolution, the vote resulted as follows:
