

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY AS TO MAXIMUM MATURITY OF BONDS**

The Council of the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, met in Legislat session on the 6th day of February, 1967, with the following members present:

Mr. Davis moved the passage of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, this Council contemplates the issuance of bonds in the sum of \$5,150 for the purpose of paying part of the cost of constructing a municipal garage with appurtenances for the Village;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Centerville, Ohio, that the Village Clerk, as fiscal officer, be and is hereby requested to certify to this council the estimated average life of the improvements to be made with the proceeds of the sale of said bonds, or the weighted maximum maturity of said bonds, and notes in anticipation thereof, as provided in Sections 133.20 and 133.21 of the Uniform Bond Law of the Ohio Revised Code.

Mr. McIntire seconded the resolution, and the roll being called upon its passage, the vote resulted as follows:
