

RESOLUTION NO. 4-64

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR EMPLOYMENT OF SPECIAL BOND COUNSEL INCIDENT TO NECESSARY LEGISLATION AND LEGAL ASSISTANCE IN ISSUANCE OF \$35,000.00 VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL BUILDING BONDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The law firms of Peck, Shaffer & Williams, Special Bond Counsel, Cincinnati, Ohio, and William Wiseman be and the same are hereby retained by the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio, to handle all legislation and preparation of all proceedings in connection with the authorization and issuance of general obligation bonds, bond forms, notice of sale, checking and approving all contracts for the proposed Municipal Building of the Village of Centerville, Ohio.

SECTION 2.

The total and/or combined fee for both Peck, Shaffer & Williams and William Wiseman shall be no <sup>more</sup> less than one (1%) per cent of the cost of said improvement, payable when the bonds are issued.

SECTION 3.

It is further understood and agreed that the above legal services do not include representation in any law suits growing out of claim for damages, any litigation or other collateral proceedings not ordinarily incident to the issuance of general obligation bonds.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
