

RESOLUTION NO. 2

DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO IMPROVE STREETS,  
AVENUES, PUBLIC ROADS AND PUBLIC PLACES IN  
THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, STATE OF OHIO,  
BY LIGHTING THE SAME WITH ELECTRICITY.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Center-  
ville, State of Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1. That it is conducive to the public convenience  
and welfare and is necessary to improve the streets, avenues, public  
roads, and public places in the Village of Centerville, State of  
Ohio, by lighting the same with electricity as hereinafter set  
forth.

The extent of the lighting in the zones aforesaid shall  
be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates  
heretofore prepared by the Village Council and now on file in the  
Office of the Clerk of this Village, and said plans, specifications  
and estimates are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. THAT THE COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE  
PAID AS FOLLOWS:

TWO PER CENT (2%) of the total cost and the cost of  
intersections shall be paid by the Village of Centerville at Large  
out of the GENERAL FUND.

All other remaining costs which shall include the expenses  
of preliminary and other surveys and of printing and publishing the  
notices, resolutions and ordinances required, and of serving said  
notices, the costs of construction and all other necessary expend-  
itures shall be paid by assessments in proportion to the benefits  
which may result from the improvement upon the following described  
lots and lands, to wit:

SECTION 3. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five (5) annual installments which installments shall be certified by the Clerk of this Village to the County Auditor as required by law.

SECTION 4. That notice of the passage of this resolution be given to the owners of the lots and lands to be assessed for the payment of the costs and expenses of such improvements by posting a copy of this resolution in five conspicuous places as required by law, within the Village.

SECTION 5. That bonds shall not be issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments so to be levied.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
