

VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

RESOLUTION NO. 5 - 1959

DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF A LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of taxes at the maximum rate authorized by the Revised Code Section 5705.02 on the taxable property in said Village will be insufficient to provide adequate amounts for the necessary requirements of said Village and that it is necessary for the purpose of providing additional funds for current expenses of said Village that taxes be levied on the taxable property in said Village for the period of five (5) years, at a rate in excess of such maximum rate authorized by said Revised Code Section 5705.02.

SECTION 2. That, in addition to the total tax rate of 28.8 mills now in effect with respect to taxable property in said Village of Centerville, it is necessary to levy a tax for current expenses for the tax years 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962 and 1963 at the rate for each tax year of not exceeding three and one-half (3.5) mills on each dollar of the tax valuation of the taxable property within the Village of Centerville, Ohio, which amounts to \$0.35 for each \$100.00 of tax valuation.

SECTION 3. That the Clerk be, and he hereby is, directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Montgomery County, Ohio, in order that said Board of Elections may make the necessary arrangements for the submission of such question to the electors of said Village, as provided by law and to notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by the Revised Code Section 5705.25.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately.
