

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3 .. - 1957

VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

A RESOLUTION of the Village Council of Centerville rescinding its former resolution passed the 6th day of May, 1957, authorizing the expenditure of funds for preliminary survey by the Village Engineer relating to installation of sewers.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the resolution of the ~~28~~⁶ day of May, 1957, by this Council authorizing the expenditure of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the services of Leo Wall, Village Engineer, in connection with and in relation to a preliminary survey for the installation of sewers and a sewage disposal system and plant for the Village of Centerville be, and the same is hereby, rescinded until further action of this Council.

Section 2. This action is taken pending further analysis and study of the financial arrangements requisite to an installation of adequate sewage facilities for the said Village.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately.
