

RESOLUTION NO. 10

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY THE DIRECTOR OF HEALTH OF THE STATE OF OHIO RELATIVE TO THE APPROVAL OF THE DETAIL PLANS OF PROPOSED SANITARY SEWERAGE SYSTEM AND SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS, the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio, did receive a letter dated September 29, 1948, from John D. Porterfield, M.D. Director of Health, State of Ohio, said letter approving detail plans of proposed sanitary sewerage system and sewage treatment plant as prepared by the Ralph L. Woolpert Company, Engineers, said approval subject to the following conditions:

1st. That the village shall pass and enforce ordinances satisfactory to the Director of Health containing the following provisions:

a. Prohibiting the establishment or maintenance of privies, cesspools and private sewers on premises accessible to the public sanitary sewers, and requiring connections for such premises.

b. Prohibiting the discharge into sanitary sewers of roof water, surface or subsoil drainage and other clean waste waters.

c. Prohibiting the discharge of sewage into storm drains.

d. Providing for the issuance of permits for sewer connections and for inspection and recording thereof.

2nd. That the village shall provide for proper maintenance of the entire sewerage system and for proper operation of the sewage pumping stations;

3rd. That the village of Centerville shall obtain the right to discharge the effluent of the sewage treatment plant to the watercourse indicated on the plans, from the owner of the lands upon which the receiving watercourse is located;

4th. That the village shall provide for technical supervision of the operation of the sewage treatment plant and that daily records of operation shall be maintained and submitted to the State Department of Health at monthly intervals;

5th. That any major additions to or deviation from the approved plan shall have received the approval of the State Department of Health before such additions or deviations are incorporated in the work;

6th. That additional sewage treatment facilities shall be installed when deemed necessary by the Director of Health; and

7th. That this approval shall become void January 1, 1950, unless the construction of the proposed work shall have been substantially started prior to that date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the above listed conditions imposed by the Director of Health, State of Ohio, be accepted by the Village of Centerville.

Section 2: That the resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to the preservation of the health, peace, and safety of the Village of Centerville, Montgomery County, State of Ohio, and the citizens thereof, and shall go into immediate effect.
