Declaring it necessary to improve Weller Avenue in the Village of Centerville, Ohio, from Main Street to East Avenue:

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio, all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Weller Avenue from Main Street to East Avenue in a manner described in the attached plans and specifications which are hereby made a part hereof.

Section 2. That the grade of said street, as improved, shall be as shown on the attached profile and engineer's plans which are made a part hereof.

Section 3. That in connection with said improvement it Is necessary to construct curbs and gutters on part of said street as shown on the attached plans, profiles and specifications which are made a part hereof.

Section 4. That the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement, heretofore prepared by the engineer for said Village and now on file in the office of the Mayor of said Village, be and the same hereby are approved.

Section 5. That the whole cost of said improvement and the cost and expense of proceedings hereunder shall be paid out of the general fund of said Village, except that the cost of curbs and gutters shall be assessed at a rate not to exceed seventy cents (70¢) per frontfoot upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement; said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specifically benefited by said improvement. The balance of the cost of said curbs and gutters, if any, shall be paid by the Village of Centerville out of its general fund.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
