RESOLUTION NO. 4-1944.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THOMAS J. DAVIS FOR THE SURFACE THEATMENT OF EAST AVENUE, MARTHA AVENUE, LAURA AVENUE AND LUCAS DRIVE WITHIN THE BORTH, SOUTH, EAST AND WEST PAURDARIES OF LUCAS PARK SUPPLYISION, WHICH IS RECORDED IN VOLUME "T", OF PAGE 35 OF THIS PLAT RECORDS OF MONTGOINERY COUNTY, ONIO, THE SAID THOMAS J. DAVIS HAVING AOREED TO CONTRIBUTE THE SUM OF RIGHT HUMBRED AND PIFTY (\$850.00) BOLLARS TOWARD THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION A STORM SINER DOWN EAST AVENUE.

WE IT RESERVED by the Council of the Village of

Centerville, in the County of Mentgomery and State of Chio;

Section 1: That the Village of Centerville will surfacestreat Mast Avenue, Martha Avenue, Laura Avenue and Zucas Drive within the north, south, east and west boundaries of Lucas Park Subdivision, which is recorded in Volume U, on page 88 of the Plat Records of Montgomery County, Ohio, with a top dressing of not less than two (2) inches of gravel or crushed soons screenings bound with penetration asphalt or read oil applied at the rate of che-half (1/2) gallon per square yard, which work will be done within the construction season of 1944, upon the payment by the said Thomas J. Davis of the sum of Eight hundred and fifty (\$850.00) Dellars toward the cost of constructing a storm sever down East Avenue and the bringing of said streets otherwise up to the point where they are ready for surface-treatment.

Section 2: That the payment by the said Thomas J. Davis of said sum of Bight hundred and fifty (\$950.00) Dollars, the Village Clerk's receipt therefor, and this resolution shall constitute a contract with the said Thomas J. Davis that the Village of Centerville will surface-treat said streets as aforesaid within the construction season of 1944.

Section 3: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the eatliest period allowed by law.
