RESOLUTION NO. 2 - 1942.

A RESOLUTION OF SYMPATHY AND RESPECT FOR JOSEPH S. LUCAS,  
A MEMBER OF THIS COUNCIL, WHO DIED ON THE 19TH DAY OF  
DECEMBER, 1941.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Center-  
ville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio:
