RESOLUTION NO. 6 - 1942.

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO BEGIN PROCEEDINGS IN THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, TO QUIET THE TITLE TO THE PUBLIC ALLEY RUNNING SOUTH FROM WEST FRANKLIN STREET BETWEEN LOTS NOS. 18 and 34 ON THE ROBBINS PLAT.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, that, in view of the continued practice of obstructing the flow of traffic in the public alley between Lots Nos. 18 and 34 on the Robbins Plat, which alley runs south from West Franklin Street in the Village of Centerville, the Village Solicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to begin appropriate proceedings in the Court of Common Pleas of Montgomery County, Ohio, to quiet the title to said alley and for all other and proper relief; that this resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
