RESOLUTION NO. 1 -¹⁹⁴¹~~1940~~

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE VILLAGE SOLICITOR ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE TO INSTITUTE A SUIT IN CONJUNCTION WITH A NUMBER OF PROPERTY OWNERS IN THE VICINITY AGAINST CHARLES AND OPAL MENDENHALL TO PREVENT THEM FROM BUILDING A COW STABLE ON THEIR PROPERTY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That should Charles and Opal Mendenhall begin the construction of a cow stable on their lands in the southeast portion of the Village, that the Village Solicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to bring a proceeding in the Court of Common Pleas of Montgomery County, Ohio, in conjunction with the property owners in the vicinity in an effort to prevent the construction of said cow stable.

Section 2. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized and directed in the name of the Village to execute the necessary bond in connection with the issuance of a temporary injunction, which bond shall not exceed the sum of \$500,000.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
