RESOLUTION NO. 5 - 1940.

Resolution of Municipality Proposing to Cooperate With the Director of Highways

WHEREAS, the public interest demands the improvement hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Centerville....., State of Ohio, desires to cooperate with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, in accomplishing said improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Centerville....., State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the public interest demands the improvement, under the provisions of Section 1189 and related sections of the General Code of Ohio, of that part of State Highway No. 64....., situated in the Village of Centerville....., County of Montgomery....., and State of Ohio, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the concrete pavement stops and the bituminous pavement begins, thence in a southerly direction along said Main Street to the south corporation, a distance of approximately 0.6 miles, and

Section 2. That the Council of the Village of Centerville....., State of Ohio, does hereby propose to cooperate with the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, in the

} of the above described portion of State Highway No. 64....., by assuming and contributing

One thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars....., inclusive of engineering, preliminary contingencies and other incidental expenses.
