

RESOLUTION NO. 6 1940.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ENGINEER TO PREPARE PLANS, PROFILES, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF WELLER AVENUE, MARTHA AVENUE AND EAST AVENUE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, three-fourths of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That in view of the improvement of Main Street under a joint arrangement between the State Highway Department, W. P. A. and the Village, there will be available considerable fill and base material suitable for the improvement at small cost to the village of our unimproved streets.

Section 2. That the Village Engineer be and he hereby is authorized and directed to proceed immediately with the preparation of plans, profiles, specifications and estimates for the improvement of Weller Avenue from Main Street to East Avenue, of Martha Avenue from Main Street to East Avenue and of East Avenue from Martha Avenue north to Franklin Street, which improvement shall include necessary grading and drainage together with the construction of a proper subgrade.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
