

RESOLUTION NO. 10 1940.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING TO IMPROVE EAST AVENUE FROM WELLER AVENUE SOUTH TO MARTHA AVENUE AND MARTHA AVENUE FROM EAST AVENUE WEST TO MAIN STREET BY GRADING, CONSTRUCTING SUITABLE FOUNDATIONS THEREFOR AND ROUGH SURFACING THE SAME FROM MATERIALS AVAILABLE ON ACCOUNT OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF MAIN STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve East Avenue from Weller Avenue south to Martha Avenue and Martha Avenue from East Avenue West to Main Street by grading, constructing suitable foundations therefor and rough surfacing the same from materials available on account of the improvement of Main Street.

Section 2. That the grade of said avenues as improved shall be the new grade established by ordinance No. 8 1940 passed on the vii day of July, 1940.

Section 3. That the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement heretofore prepared by the Village Engineer and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk be and the same are hereby approved.

Section 4. That the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid out of the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund.

Section 5. That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the public peace, health and safety of the Village of Centerville require the immediate improvement of said avenues between the points aforesaid because of the materials immediately available on account of the improvement of Main Street, which would otherwise be lost to the Village, and shall take effect upon its passage.
