

RESOLUTION NO. 17 1940.

A RESOLUTION REPEALING INFORMAL RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 11th DAY OF MAY, 1938, APPOINTING ENGINEER TO MAKE SURVEY OF VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE LOOKING TO THE PREPARATION OF PLANS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERS IN THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, by informal resolution this Council on the 11th day of May, 1938, appointed an engineer to make a survey of the Village of Centerville looking to the preparation of plans for the construction of sanitary sewers in the Village; and,

WHEREAS, said action is now considered untimely and impossible of accomplishment within the limits of reasonable cost; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this council to terminate any possible arrangements with the engineer so named in said resolution looking to the construction of sanitary sewers in this village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Centerville, in the County of Montgomery and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That said resolution duly passed by the council on the 11th day of May, 1938, appointing an engineer to make a survey of the Village of Centerville looking to the preparation of plans for the construction of sanitary sewers in the village, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That any possible arrangements with the engineer so named in said resolution looking to the construction of sanitary sewers in this village be and the same hereby are terminated, cancelled and held for naught.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
