A RESOLUTION ENACTED BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY/LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY OR "LPA" IN THE MATTER OF THE MOT-48-4.28, STATE ROUTE 48 (NORTH MAIN STREET) & STATE ROUTE 725 (ALEX-BELL ROAD) TRAFFIC SIGNAL REPLACEMENT PROJECT, PID NO. 113373.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside monies for the Construction Federal Safety (HSIP) funds through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, LPA has applied and been selected for funding through the Ohio Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the MOT-48-4.28 project described as:

Replacement and upgrade of the existing traffic signal and related equipment at the intersection of State Route 48 (North Main Street) and State Route 725 (Alex-Bell Road), within the City of Centerville; and

WHEREAS, the MOT-SR 48-4.28 project is eligible to receive federal funds.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:


SECTION 1: That the City of Centerville as the LPA shall enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio for the MOT-SR48-4.28 project, a copy of said agreement is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein; and that the City Manager be, and is hereby authorized to execute said agreement.

SECTION 2: This Resolution becomes effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
