AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 13-1959 AND ORDINANCE 10-1961 SECTION 2 (a) INCREASING PERMIT FEE REQUIRED

BE IT ORDAINED by the COUNCIL of the VILLAGE of CENTERVILLE, OHIO, that:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance Number 13-1959, as amended by Ordinance Number 10-1961 Section 2 (a), reads as follows:

"Section 2 (a) The person, firm or corporation desiring to acquire such a permit for the purpose of tapping into or connecting with any sanitary sewer line shall make application, in writing, to the Chairman of the Street Committee of the Village of Centerville. Before the Street Committee shall issue such permit, the applicant shall be required to pay a permit fee of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars to cover necessary administrative and engineering expenses and to deposit the sum of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars. The permit fee and the deposit so required shall be paid in cash, certified check or

postal money order to the Chairman of the Street Committee of the Village Council, who shall, in turn, transfer the deposit to the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village Council, and thereafter the permit shall issue."

SECTION 2. That the foregoing Ordinance Number 13-1959, Section 2, as amended by Ordinance Number 10-1961, Section 2 (a), be amended as follows:

"Section 2 (a) The person, firm or corporation desiring to acquire such a permit for the purpose of tapping into or connecting with any sanitary sewer line shall make application, in writing, to the Chairman of the Street Committee of the Village of Centerville. Before the Street Committee shall issue such permit, the applicant shall be required to pay a permit fee of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars to cover necessary administrative and engineering expenses and to deposit the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars. The permit fee and the deposit so required shall be paid in cash, certified check or postal money order to the Chairman of the Street Committee of the Village Council, who shall, in turn, transfer the deposit to the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village Council, and thereafter the permit shall issue."

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law and that all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and revoked.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 13-61 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, UNDER SECTION 36.46 ADOPTED NOVEMBER 30, 1959 CONTROLLING THE CUTTING OF WEEDS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 13-1961, Section 36.46, Code of Ordinances, reads as follows:

Any person owning or having charge of land within the village, shall keep said property free and clear from all noxious weeds and rank vegetation and shall be required to cut all such weeds and vegetation on the lots owned or controlled by him at least twice in every year, once between the first of June and the first of July and once between the first of August and the fifteenth of August

and that said section be amended to read as follows:

Any person owning or having charge of land within the village, shall keep said property free and clear from all noxious weeds and rank vegetation and shall be required to cut all such weeds and vegetation on the lots owned or controlled by him at least twice in every year, once between the first of June and the fifteenth of June and once between the first of August and the fifteenth of August.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law and that all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and revoked.
