by deed recorded in Book 2112, Page 461 in the Deed Records of Montgomery County,Ohio, said point being also the southeast corner of said Siebenthaler Company, Inc., land; thence with the east line of said Siebenthaler Company, Inc., land North seven degrees forty-seven minutes ten seconds  $(7^{\circ} 47' 10")$ West for five hundred thirty-three and 73/100 (533.73) feet to the point of beginning containing three and 926/100 (3.926) acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. A map of the area herein zoned, marked Exhibit "A" attached and made a part hereof, has been submitted to the Planning Commission and approved.

SECTION 3. Any ordinance, resolution, or any part thereof, in conflict hereto is hereby rescinded and repealed.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 5 - 1963 VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1-43 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING PARKING REGULATIONS ON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS IN SAID VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Parking on West side of North Main Street from the intersection of a public alley north of Franklin Street, North forty-five (45) feet be restricted to police vehicles.

SECTION 2. One diagonal parking space on Northwest corner on North side of public alley running parallel to South side of Washington Township Hall be restricted to police vehicles.

SECTION 3. The parking adjacent and parell to the South side of Washington Township Hall in the area so provided be restricted to one (1) hour parking between the hours of 9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law and shall revoke and rescind all other ordinance and resolution or any part thereof in conflict herewith.
