WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare that this Ordinance take effect at the earliest date allowed by law,

> THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO, THAT,

Section 1. The annual salary for members of the Police Department shall be as follows:

Section 2. All members of the Police Department shall receive vacations determined by length of service, as follows:

1 Year Service 1 week with pay 3 years service 2 weeks with pay

10 years service

3 weeks with pay

Section 3. It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Village Marshall to prepare and submit monthly work schedule of said department to the legislative authority through the Office of Mayor.

Section 4. It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Village Marshall to prepare and submit, in duplicate, an activities report each month, to the legislative authority through the Office of Mayor.

Section 5. All applicants for employment by the Village of Centerville, for positions on the police department, shall furnish at said applicant's cost, report on examination conducted by a qualified physician.

Section 6. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be repealed, and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
