AN ORDINANCE TO FINALLY APPOINT Morte Adams, Jr., AS VILLAGE PATROLMAN.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That Morte Adams, Jr., Franklin Street, Centerville, Ohio, is hereby finally appointed as Village Patrolman.

Section 2. This Ordinance is passed as an emergency measure under the Laws of the State of Ohio. An emergency is declared to exist by reason of the immediate necessity of strenthening police protection in the interest of public welfare and safety.
