ORDINANCE NUMBER 2-1960  
VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF AND TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE VILLAGE ENGINEER.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio.

Section 1. That the Village of Centerville, Ohio, shall be authorized to employ a qualified person to serve as the Village Engineer, who shall be a civil engineer, so licensed to practice such profession by the State of Ohio; that he shall serve under the authority of, and subject to the direction and control of the Village Council. His tenure shall be subject to the discretion of said Council.

Section 2. That the duties of the Village Engineer shall be the planning, supervision and inspection of all public improvement and construction within the Village as directed by Council, the Village Planning Commission, or delegated representatives or committees of either acting within the scope of their authority, and such supervision or inspection as may relate directly or indirectly to the enforcement of the zoning ordinances or building code, or Subdivision Regulations of said Village, or such other ordinances, resolutions or directives for the promotion of the public safety, health or welfare within the Village of Centerville.

Section 3. That the compensation to the Village Engineer for his professional services shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

Attendance at Council meetings for the first  
24 meetings during any one year....per meeting: \$ 5.00

Attendance at any more than 24 meetings, no  
compensation shall be paid.

Attendance at any Village Board meeting...  
per meeting: 10.00

Other professional services and consultations  
performed by said Village Engineer shall be  
paid on an hourly basis in the amount of \$8.00  
per hour. In the event engineering services  
are rendered by an employee of the Village  
Engineer, the compensation paid per hour shall  
be according to the classification of the em-  
ployee as follows:

Draftsmen, rodmen, etc....	3.75 per hour
Designers....	5.25 per hour
Engineers....	6.25 per hour

Section 4. That Mr. Frank W. Williams, 155 West Spring Valley Road, Centerville Ohio, a registered and licensed civil engineer of the State of Ohio, is hereby employed as the Village Engineer for the Village of Centerville, Ohio, under the terms and conditions set forth above, his employment to be effective January 1st, 1960, and thereafter to serve as provided by law and at the pleasure of this Council.

Section 5. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure under the law of the State of Ohio, the existing emergency being the immediate need for continuous engineering services by competent and qualified personnel.

Section 6. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be repealed and this ordinance shall take effect from and after the 4th day of January, 1960.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 3-1960  
VILLAGE OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF AND TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE VILLAGE SOLICITOR AND TO RATIFY AND APPROVE THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. ANTHONY R. LAIR AS SUCH VILLAGE SOLICITOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Centerville, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Village of Centerville, Ohio, shall be authorized to employ a qualified person to serve as the Village Solicitor, who shall be an Attorney-at-Law, admitted to practice in the Courts of Ohio. Such Solicitor shall be employed by the Council for a period not exceeding two (2) years.

Section 2. That it shall be the duty of such Solicitor to act as Attorney for the Village and the officers thereof in their official capacities and as such Attorney, prosecute and defend all actions by or against the Village or any department or office thereof during the term of his employment; to prepare ordinances and resolutions; and to render legal opinions to the Council or to any department or officer of the Village upon request in writing.

Section 3. That the compensation to the Village Solicitor for his professional services shall be, as follows:

Attendance at one regular meeting per month;  
giving of legal opinions, either written or  
oral, as requested; preparation of Village  
ordinances and resolutions; acting as  
prosecutor in ordinance violation cases,  
Annual Fee: \$800.00

Fees for services rendered, in addition  
to the above-named normal services, shall  
be charged in accordance with the Dayton  
Bar Association Minimum Fee Schedule. In  
the event the fee for a particular service  
is not established by the Dayton Bar Associ-  
ation Minimum Fee Schedule, then the charge  
shall be predicated on an hourly fee basis, in  
accordance with the Dayton Bar Association  
Hourly Fee Rate, by using the Minimum Hourly  
Fee Rate as a Maximum fee charge.

Section 4. That the appointment of Anthony R. Lair, an Attorney at Law, admitted to practice in the Courts of the State of Ohio, of 66 Hampton Avenue, Centerville, Ohio, by the Mayor of Centerville, as of the 1st day of January, 1960, is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed and he shall continue to serve as provided by law.

Section 5. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure under the law of the State of Ohio, the existing emergency being the immediate need for continuous legal services by competent and qualified personnel.

Section 6. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be repealed and this ordinance shall take effect from and after the 4th day of January, 1960.
